Xylocaine® Ointment

Composition

Each gm of ointment contains :

Lidocaine USP 50 mg.

Constituents q.s.

Description :Xylocaine® ointment contains 5% Xylocaine base (lignocaine) in a vehicle consisting of carbowaxes and propylene glycol. Xylocaine base penetrates the tissues and exerts a powerful anaesthetic action. The ointment is easily removed with water and does not interfere with the process of healing.

Indications : Pain control in e.g. mild non-extensive burns and sunburns, X-ray injuries, sore nipples and herpetic lesions, various anal conditions, e.g. haemorrhoids and fissures, proctoscopy and sigmoidoscopy, herpes zoster., pruritus., dentistry eg. deep scaling.

Adverse effects: Allergic reactions to Xylocaine® are extremely rare. To avoid toxic reactions the lowest dosage providing adequate analgesia should be used.

Dosage The ointment should be applied as a thin layer. On broken tissue a sterile gauze pad may be used for application.

Presentation : Xylocaine® 5% ointment in tubes of 10 gm and 20 gm.
